

Stuttgart Pragstrasse Germany



In November 2019, additional 10 MANN+HUMMEL Filter Cubes III went into operation at a third, highly polluted location in Stuttgart's Pragstrasse over a section of 125 metres. Regarding the project, the Baden-Württemberg Ministry of Transport emphasized in a statement that the aim is "to reduce air pollution with nitrogen oxides in the areas with the highest levels of pollution, the so-called hotspots [...]". The ministry continues: "The columns represent a concrete measure to protect residents from harmful nitrogen dioxide."
